- Harrisburg Pike/Good Drive – signal improvements-timing improvements (pending Woodcrest Villa expansion).
- Road/Bridge projects:
 - State Road (Interchange/bridge widening) -
 - December/2018 bid let date, construction in 2019, 2 yr. project.
 - Centerville-North (Bunny to Gloucester) –
 - Project has been extended to end of October due to weather conditions, project changes and pole relocations.
 - Centerville-South (Marietta to Columbia widening) - no updates
 - Twp attorney working on Manor Twp and EHT agreement re: cost sharing
 - Holland Street bridge (removal) –
 - PennDOT working on Engineering Agreement supplement
 - Awaiting clearance from PennDOT Environmental Dept. re historic clearance
 - Old Rohrerstown Road bridge (realignment) -
 - Awaiting project funding supplement #3 to account for LASA sewer line work.
 - LASA/Twp. reimbursement agreement under review by PennDOT.
 - Gentry Heights (stormwater/curbing/water line/resurfacing) -
 - Authority has begun installation of water line
 - Twp. bidding should occur early 2019.
 - Running Pump round-a-bout-no updates
 - Construction date has been delayed until summer/2019 to allow Lanc. City to install a 42” water line. Right-of-way negotiations will occur this year.
