

**East Hempfield Township
Traffic Commission Minutes**

Date and Time: June 15, 2016 6:15 p.m.

Commission members in attendance: John Bingham, Stephen Skiles and Ed LeFevre.

Others present: Robert Krimmel, Cindy Schweitzer, Perry Madonna, and Andrew Stern.

The meeting was called to order at 6:15 pm by Mr. Bingham, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Comment: none

Old Business:

State Road/Yellow Goose Traffic signal permit application to PennDOT – Craig Mellott, Traffic Planning & Design Inc. and Attorney James Clymer were present to explain their request to have the Township submit the necessary paperwork to PennDOT to allow adding a signal to the T intersection at State Road and Yellow Goose which will make the intersection a 4-way signal with the construction of Blackburn Drive. The Commission supported moving this to the Board of Supervisors for consideration.

Paddington Drive/Nolt Road traffic concern – Mr. Madonna explained that he has spoken to the owner of the property on the North side of the intersection and he supports the no parking area. He appreciates that the problem was brought to the attention of the Commission as he has seen some near misses due to vehicles parked close to the intersection. Motioned by Chief Skiles, seconded by Mr. LeFevre and unanimously carried to authorize placement of ‘no parking here to corner’ on the north and south side of Paddington Drive for a distance of approximately 25 feet.

New Business:

Steinmetz Coins & Currency Inc., 350 Centerville Road – Mr. Bingham explains that he was approached by Mr. Steinmetz to see if a street sign could be placed at the entrance to Old Centerville Road so that customers would be able to find his business through a Google search. Mr. Stern and Mr. Madonna explained that “Old Centerville Road” is not a public street but a driveway. The area was vacated by the Township at the request of the Bob Evans Restaurant in order to satisfy parking requirements. It is suggested that Mr. Steinmetz work with Bob Evans Restaurant to provide some signage or possibly request a change of street address from the Township that better reflects their location.

Minutes:

Motioned by Chief Skiles, seconded by Mr. LeFevre and unanimously carried to accept the minutes of May 18, 2016 as submitted.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned by the unanimous consent of the Commission.
