Bank Street truck traffic – Mrs. Schweitzer was contacted by Jason Confair regarding his concerns with the increased truck traffic and speed on Bank Street. Mr. Confair was not present however Chief Skiles and Perry Madonna viewed the roadway and surrounding properties. The conclusion is that there are many businesses in the area that have truck traffic due to their business needs so local delivery signage would have no impact. A brief discussion was also held regarding the placement of ‘child at play’ signage. Bank Street is unusually wide due to the former trolley track area and while ‘child at play’ signage could be place there does not appear to be a critical need since the street is straight and wide. Staff will review the school signage to make sure it is appropriate.

Traffic Signal @ Rohrerstown/Noll and Rohrerstown/Embassy – The PennDOT traffic signal applications were reviewed. They will need Township signature to move forward with the PennDOT technical review. Motioned by Mr. Bingaman, seconded by Chief Skiles and unanimously carried to recommend to the Board of Supervisors that they adopt resolutions 2016-22 and 2016-23, authorizing signature on both applications.
