New Business:

- **Wheatland Hills, Glenbrook Community Organization** – Stephani Velar and representatives of the Glenbrook Community Organization were present to review the materials they had submitted previously to the Commission which explained their concerns with cut-through traffic in their neighborhood. They stressed a desire to work with the Township to come up with solutions to the problem. Varied options were discussed which included ‘no thru or no outlet’ signage, stop bars at intersections, and yard signs. Motioned by Mr. Bingham, seconded by Mr. LeFevre and unanimously carried to authorize staff to investigate the costs to add reflective bars to the stop sign posts and some ideas for creative signage to alert drivers that
- **Handicap parking sign-2205 Wood Street** – Phyllis Peartree explained her need and request for a handicap parking space and signage at her residence, 2205 Wood Street. Motioned by Mr. Bingham, seconded by Mr. LeFevre and unanimously carried to grant the placement of a handicap parking space at 2205 Wood Street with an expiration of five years October/2021), at which point it will be considered for renewal.
