

Central Lancaster County Council of Government
July 25, 2018 8:00 a.m. West Hempfield Township Municipal Building

The meeting of the Central Lancaster County Council of Government (CLCCOG) was called to order at 8:00 a.m. In attendance: Al Kling (MT), Tom O'Brien (MT), Sean Molchany (MT), Todd Weiss (EPB), Cindy Schweitzer, (EHT), Andrew Stern (WHT), Kent Gardner (WHT), Ethan Demme (ELT), Ralph Hutchison (EHT), Doug Brubaker, (EHT), Robert Krimmel (EHT)

Visitors and Public Comment – Allyson Gibson, Clean Water Partners was present to get to know the group and explained the goals of the partnership.

Discussions:

East Hempfield Township:

- It was noted that the West Roseville bridge has been removed which was one of the three bridges that were part of the PennDOT P3 initiative. Mr. Molchany added that the Miller Road bridge is working through utility issues and the Lititz Road bridge is scheduled for completion by October 10th.
- Old Rohrerstown Road bridge – LASA's has been brought up to speed in the project which now involves moving a major sewer main. Let date is scheduled for 2019.
- Centerville Road – North is on schedule with an anticipated early October opening.
- State Road is still on a let date schedule for November/2018.
- Spooky Nook Partners is doing a traffic scoping study, looking at development traffic impact on Spooky Nook Road on the south and north side of Route 283.
- Wireless Facilities Ordinance draft is being reviewed. Draft was prepared by the Cohen Law Group. Mr. Weiss also indicated that the Borough is also looking at doing an ordinance to address this issue.

Manheim Township:

- Mr. Molchany indicated that the Township is holding off doing anything with fireworks regulations as he has heard the state legislators may be making changes given all the complaints from across the state.

East Petersburg Borough:

- The rezoning for the Traditions of America project is moving along.
- Ms. Gibson thanked the Borough for hosting the water week event.

West Hempfield Township:

- Friday, 7/27 is scheduled as move in day for the Township's new building.
- The gas pipeline is almost completed with gas to be flowing any day.
- Mr. Stern provided the following explanation of P3 (public, private partnership) – PennDOT gives bridge repair work to private contractors to repair.

East Lampeter Township:

- Lincoln Highway Streetscape project is still in process. There was a signal system issue which has added to the congestion in the area.
- Clean up of the Conestoga Creek was done in June during water week and Mr. Hutchinson is willing to share any of the materials they used.
- Stormwater Fee study is in process which includes data gathering, analysis and community outreach.
- Eden Road and Old Mill Crossing will be closed for approximately 18 months.

Old Business:

- The Crossings Project – A question was raised concerning the stormwater system for this project. Mr. Molchany indicated it is 85-90% installed. There was discussion regarding how it is functioning and if other areas have seen any impact. No one was aware of any impacts.

New Business:

- The new recycling rules put out by LCSWMA were discussed. Still too early to fully understand the impact to those of us who contract for disposal services. Mr. Stern questioned the conflict between LCSWMA rules and how recycling is described in his hauler contract.

Minutes: On motioned by Mr. O'Brien seconded by Mr. Stern and unanimously carried to accept the minutes of May 23, 2018, as presented.

Adjournment: There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 9:00 am by the consent of the group

Next Meeting: Will be held at East Lampeter Township on September 26th, 8am.
